UNION OF CONCERNED SCIENTISTS' MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO REPLY TO LICENSEE'S MOTION TO EXCLUDE UCS FROM PARTICIPATION

On July 31, 1984, Licensee moved to exclude the Union of Concerned Scientists from participation in certain aspects of the remand on management issues. Under the Commission's rules, UCS' reply would normally be due to be filed on August 15, 1984.
