SUBJECT: NOTICE OF VIOLATION AND DEVIATION (NRC INSPECTION REPORT NOS. 50-369/95-23 AND 50-370/95-23)

Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Richard S. Baldwin, of this office during the week of September 25, 1995. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for your McGuire Nuclear Station. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observation of activities in progress. The purpose of the inspection was to determine whether activities authorized by the license were conducted safely and in accordance with NRC requirements.

Based on the results of this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Notice of Violation (Notice), and other activities appeared to deviate from commitments to the NRC, as specified in the enclosed Notice of Violation (Notice) and Notice of Deviation. The violations were cited for inadequate procedures in the area of hydrogen recombiners and inadequate corrective actions in the area of medical evaluation and reporting requirements. We are concerned about the violations and deviations because your corrective actions for the previous violations did not prevent reoccurrance and the noted surveillance procedure contained inadequate acceptance criteria.

You are required to respond to this letter and should follow the instructions specified in the enclosed Notices when preparing your response. In your response, you should document the specific actions taken and any additional actions you plan to take to correct the above violations and deficiencies and to prevent recurrence. Your response may reference or include previous docketed correspondence, if the correspondence adequately addresses the required response. After reviewing your response to this Notice, including your proposed corrective actions and the results of future inspections, the NRC will determine whether further NRC enforcement action is necessary to ensure compliance with NRC regulatory requirements.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosures will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.

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The responses directed by this letter and the enclosed Notices are not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Management and Budget as required by the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, Pub. L. 96-511.
