MODIFICATION OF PARTIAL INITIAL DECISION

In our Partial Initial Decision dated October 31, 1995, LBP-95-19, we determined that GANE's Contention 5 was moot based on the removal by Georgia Tech from the site of fuel and certain other materials--in particular, a Cesium-137 source--from the site during the 1996 Olympic Games. In considering GANE's August 31, 1995 filing, which stated that Georgia Tech intended to remove the Cesium-137 source, no party had objected to that representation by GANE and we thus included the source among the materials to be removed.

The Staff has now informed counsel for the ASLBP that the Cesium-137 is not under NRC's jurisdiction but is regulated by the State of Georgia under the came license as the Cobalt-60 that we discussed elsewhere in the Decision.

We advised the parties of this development by telephone on November 1, 1995, noting that we are issuing a corrected LBP-95-19 that same date. This Decision treats the Cesium-137 source in the same manner as the Cobalt-60. The corrected version will be the one printed in the NRC reports, and any review by the Commission must be premised on that corrected Decision.

Accordingly, Item 1 on page 8 of the November 1, 1935 Corrected Partial Initial Decision is amended to read:

1. Contention 5, concerning security of the site during the 1996 Olympic Games, is <u>resolved</u>, subject to a condition requiring Georgia Tech to remove all fuel from the site prior to the 1996 Olympic Games and barring return of fuel until after completion of the Olympic Games.

Because the Cesium-137 was the only material of concern to GANE other than fuel for which we ordered removal, we are also amending our earlier Decision to delete any removal requirements other than those for the fuel which Georgia Tech offered to remove. (Georgia Tech may, of course, remove the Cesium-137 on its own motion but not at our direction.)

IT IS SO ORDERED.
