## Gentlemen:

Appendix H of 10CFR50 requires that a summary technical report be submitted on each surveillance capsule withdrawal and testing. Therefore, attached is the required report on Capsule ANI-A from ANO-1. It should be noted that AP&L has recently submitted and received revised Technical Specifications involving pressurization, heatup, and cooldown limitations. These new limits were based upon the previous capsule (ANI-B) analysis. The data from capsule ANI-A shows these new limits to be conservative for the approved 15 EFPY limit. Therefore, no new pressurization, heatup, and cooldown limitations are being submitted.
