Generic Letter (GL) 95-07 Response

Dear Sir:

Per discussion with Douglas V. Pickett, Clinton Power Station's NRC Project Manager, IP is providing clarification to injection valve numbers incorrectly reported in letter U-602506, dated October 16, 1995. However, the valves are injection valves as described in the letter. This information is contained on page 2 of U-602506. Listed below is the corrected information:

The High Pressure Core Spray (HPCS) injection valve number should be 1E22F004 instead of 1E22F005.

The Low Pressure Coolant Injection (LPCI) valve numbers should be 1E12F042A, B and C instead of 1E12F041A, B and C.

The Low Pressure Core Spray (LPCS) injection valve number should be 1E21F005 instead of 1E21F006.
