NRC STAFF STATUS REPORT

I. INTRODUCTION

By Memorandum and Order dated May 25, 1984, the Board directed each of the parties to this proceeding to file a status report by August 15, 1984, indicating the discovery that has occurred, the discovery that is contemplated and a suggested schedule for prehearing and hearing activities. The Staff's status report is set forth below.

II. STATUS

To date, the Staff has not conducted any discovery nor has it received any discovery requests from either Michael L. Slade (Intervenor) or Rochester Gas & Electric Corporation (Applicant). On July 13, 1984, Applicant propounded interrogatories to Intervenor, the sole remaining proponent of contentions in this proceeding. $\frac{1}{}$ However, in a notice to the Licensing Board dated July 24, 1984, Intervenor withdrew all of his

outstanding contentions. Subsequently, on August 3, 1984, Applicant filed a motion requesting that the Board terminate this proceeding.
