Dear Mr. Knubel:

By letter dated May 20, 1994, GPU Nuclear Corporation applied for an amendment to Operating License No. DPR-50 for TMI-1. The proposed change would have modified the facility Technical Specifications pertaining to the limit on maximum control rod drop time and was requested for the duration of operating cycle 10, which concluded on September 8, 1995. Based upon a telephone conversation with Mr. Jack Wetmore of your staff on November 7, 1995, it is my understanding that the application is now moot and will not be needed. Unless you notify me that my understanding is incorrect by November 29, 1995, we will consider the application as withdrawn and will file a Notice of Withdrawal of Application for Amendment to Facility Operating License with the Office of the Federal Register for publication and close this action.
