SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR WITHHOLDING INFORMATION FROM PUBLIC DISCLOSURE,
JOSEPH M. FARLEY NUCLEAR PLANT, UNITS 1 AND 2

By your application dated February 14, 1992, and affidavit dated February 18, 1992 (CAW-92-272), respectively, you submitted the following:

WCAP-13221, "Steam Generator Tube Alternate Plugging Criteria
Presentation Materials," dated February 1992.

You stated that the submitted information should be considered exempt from mandatory public disclosure for the following reason:

- A. The information reveals the distinguishing aspects of a process (or component, structure, tool, method, etc.) where prevention of its use by any of Westinghouse's competitors without license from Westinghouse constitutes a competitive economic advantage over other companies.
- B. Its use by a competitor would reduce his expenditure of resources or improve his competitive position in the design, manufacture, shipment, installation, assurance of quality, or licensing a similar product.
- C. It is not the property of Westinghouse, but must be treated as proprietary by Westinghouse according to agreements with the owner.

We have reviewed your application and the material in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.790 and, on the basis of Westinghouse Electric Corporation's statements, have determined that the submitted information sought to be withheld contains trade secrets or proprietary commercial information. Therefore, the version of the submitted information marked as proprietary will be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR 2.790(b)(5) and Section 103(b) of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended.

Withholding from public inspection shall not affect the right, if any, of persons properly and directly concerned to inspect the documents.
