Mrs. Rena Lee of 620 Blossum Dr., Rockville Md. 20850, Phone number 301-424-1920, stated that in May of 1979 she was working for a contractor (Bechtel) at the Millstone facility, doing anchor bolt inspections (Bulletin 79-02). While working in one of the units, she dropped her dosimeter and noticed that it was reading nearly off scale. She left the area, where she had been sitting on a piping run, and reported to health physics. Subsequent to Mrs. Lee reporting to health physics, the piping run was shielded.

Please provide Mrs. Lee's record of exposure, any radiological occurrence report, over exposure report or incident report, the radiation work permit (RWP) under which Mrs. Lee was working, area radiation surveys for the areas covered by the appropriate RWP, and shielding information for the areas covered by the appropriate RWP. In addition, please provide your assessment of the amount, type, and extent of the exposure received by Mrs. Lee, the method by which the exposure was determined, and any extenuating circumstances which affected your assessment of her exposure.
