The NRC staff, with technical assistance from its contractor, Idaho National Engineering Laboratory (INEL), has reviewed and evaluated the information provided by you in your letter dated June 5, 1995, related to the subject as noted above and associated requests for relief. The staff's evaluation and conclusions are contained in the enclosed Safety Evaluation (SE).

The staff has concluded that no deviations from regulatory requirements or commitments were identified in Revision 5 to the NA-1 Second Ten-Year Inservice Inspection Program Plan.

The staff has also concluded that for Requests for Relief NDE-21, NDE-22, NDE-23, NDE-24, and NDE-26, the examinations required by the Code are impracticable and that your proposed alternatives to Code requirements will provide reasonable assurance of operational readiness. Therefore, relief is granted pursuant to 10 CFR 50.55a(g)(6)(i) as requested by you.
