SUBJECT: TURKEY POINT UNITS 3 AND 4 - OBSERVATION OF PHYSICAL PROTECTION INSPECTION

Dear Mr. Goldberg:

We have coordinated with your staff for two Ukrainian security inspectors to observe an NRC security inspection at the Turkey Point site from December 11-15, 1995. This visit is sponsored by the U.S. Cooperative Threat Reduction Program, as part of a U.S.-Ukraine bilateral agreement to strengthen Ukrainian nuclear safeguards. The purpose of the visit is to allow the Ukrainians to see how NRC security inspections are conducted.

As the primary subject of the visit concerns physical protection, some of the discussion topics may be categorized as safeguards information. In order for the Ukrainians to get the maximum benefit from this visit, I am granting NRC and Florida Power and Light personnel permission under 10 CFR 73.21 (c)(2) to discuss, in the presence of the Ukrainians, material classified as safeguards information. Steve Caudill of our staff will inform the Ukrainians, prior to the visit, that all information concerning the physical security system and related topics is sensitive and not to be divulged to third parties.
