ORDER

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff has requested an extension of time until November 30, 1995, in which to file a response to the Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company's petition for review of LBP-95-17, issued October 4, 1995, by the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board.
