#### NRC STAFF'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On November 7, 1995, the Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, et al. ("Licensees") filed a petition for review of the "Memorandum and Order (Ruling on Motions for Summary Disposition)," issued by the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board in this proceeding on October 4, 1995. Pursuant to 10 C.F.R. §§ 2.710 and 2.786(b)(3), the NRC Staff's answer in response to the Licensees' petition is due to be filed on November 20, 1995.

The NRC Staff ("Staff") hereby respectfully requests that the Commission grant an extension of time until November 30, 1995, in which to file the Staff's answer in response to the Licensees' petition. This extension is necessary due to the absence from the office for many days of Staff counsel whose input and advice is required for preparation of the

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Staff's answer to the Licensees' petition, and the length of time needed to consider the important issues raised by that petition.

Counsel for the Licensees and Intervenor Ohio Citizens for Responsible Energy ("OCRE") have informed Staff counsel that those parties do not object to the grant of this requested extension of time, although OCRE requested that it be afforded a similar extension of time, to which the Staff does not object. Counsel for the Licensees has indicated that he does not object to the Commission's granting OCRE a comparable extension of time, to enable OCRE to file its answer to the Licensees' petition on November 30, 1995.
