STATEMENT OF MATERIAL FACTS IN SUPPORT  
OF THE JOINT MOTION OF SUFFOLK COUNTY  
AND NEW YORK STATE FOR SUMMARY DISPOSITION  
OF EMERGENCY PLANNING CONTENTIONS 24.0, 74 AND 75  
(RELOCATION CENTERS)

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1. LILCO has no agreement with Suffolk County to use Suffolk County Community College as a relocation center in the event of an emergency at the Shoreham plant. LILCO's Testimony on Phase II Emergency Planning Contentions 24.0, 74 and 75 (Relocation Centers), dated July 30, 1984 (hereinafter, "LILCO's proposed testimony"), at 13-15, 20-22; Direct Testimony of Robert T. Kreiling on behalf of Suffolk County Regarding Contention 24.0 (hereinafter, "Kreiling testimony"), at 2.

2. Suffolk County Community College is not relied upon in the LILCO Plan. LILCO's proposed testimony, at 21-22.

3. Neither the LILCO Plan nor LILCO's proposed testimony identifies or designates any specific relocation center(s) for use by the public during an emergency at Shoreham. LILCO's proposed testimony, at 15-16.
