

Dear Sir:

On May 19, 1995, the USNRC issued Generic Letter (GL) 92-01, Revision 1, Supplement 1, "Reactor Vessel Structural Integrity." The "Required Information" for the GL contains four parts. As required by the GL, the response to Part (1) was provided within 90 days from the date of the GL (Reference 1). In that response, PECO Energy indicated that we are an active participant in the Boiling Water Reactor Vessel and Internals Project (BWRVIP), and that we endorse the BWRVIP response as contained in Reference (2). In response to the "Required Information" in Parts (2), (3) and (4), PECO Energy endorses the BWRVIP responses as contained in Reference (3).

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With respect to Part (4), as discussed in Reference (3), the current reactor vessel integrity analyses for Peach Bottom Atomic Power Station (PBAPS), Units 2 and 3, and Limerick Generating Station (LGS), Units 1 and 2 remain valid.
