Gentlemen:

On December 21, 1989, Georgia Power Company (GPC) submitted a request to revise the entire Unit 2 Technical Specifications (TS), Appendix A to Operating License NPF-5, as a part of the Technical Specification Improvement Program (TSIP). The proposed revisions submitted were based on a suggested standard TS format and content developed jointly by the four NSSS owners groups and the NRC. The Plant Hatch Unit 2 submittal represented the lead plant effort for GE BWR/4s.

Since the 1989 submittal, many changes to the industry TSIP effort have taken place, including the NRC issuance for comments of a draft of NUREG-1433, Standard Technical Specifications for General Electric Plants, BWR/4. Due to the extent of the differences between the current standard TS and the version submitted in 1989, this submittal does not represent the industry consensus for content and format. Therefore, GPC hereby requests that the submittal dated December 21, 1989 be withdrawn.

GPC plans to continue work on TSIP with Plant Hatch Unit 2 as the lead plant for BWR/4s. We expect to begin development of a new submittal upon NRC issuance of NUREG-1433.
