

- B. If required to activate an individual's pager, perform the following:
 - Determine a non-NETS phone number for the pager holder to call back on and make a note of the full call back phone number.
 - Dial the pager number of the individual you are trying to contact listed in the Communications Log, using any touch-tone phone.
 - When you hear "Beep, Beep, Beep" enter the call back number using the touch-tone key pad on the phone you are on.
 - 4. Hang up the phone.
 - 5. Continue making other notifications per Step A.
