Re: Turkey Point Units 3 and 4 Docket Nos. 50-250 and 50-251 Physical Security Plan Revision 1

Florida Power and Light Company (FPL) has issued Revision 1 to the Turkey Point Physical Security Plan. Revision 1 of the Turkey Point Physical Security Plan implements the requirements of 10 CFR 73.56, "Personnel access authorization requirements for nuclear power plants", as published in the April 25, 1991, Federal Register, Volume 56, No. 80. FPL has determined that the revision does not decrease the safeguards effectiveness of the plan pursuant to 10 CFR 50.54 (p). Pursuant to 10 CFR 50.4 (b) (4), a description of the revision and copies PTNPSP-03 through PTNPSP-06 of the plan are enclosed.

Enclosure 1 to this letter is the summary of changes. Enclosure 2 contains directions for incorporating Revision 1 into the plan, a revised list of effective pages, and copies of Revision 1 of the plan.

The enclosed material contains safeguards information as defined by 10 CFR 73.21; its disclosure to unauthorized individuals is prohibited by Section 147 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended. Therefore, pursuant to 10 CFR 2.790 (a) (3), the enclosures are exempt from public disclosure.
