SUBJECT: NRC INSPECTION REPORT NOS. 50-313/92-06; 50-368/92-06

This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. A. B. Earnest of this office during the period February 18-21, 1992. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for your Arkansas Nuclear One facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed report.

The inspection involved the review of certain areas of your physical security program.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. These areas included selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

Based on the results of this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of NPC requirements. Two noncited violations are discussed in paragraphs 3.1 and 3.2 of the enclosed inspection report. These violations are being classified as noncited violations because your actions in identifying and correcting the violation met the criteria specified in Section VII.B.(2) of the Enforcement Policy. These noncited violations involved the failure to perform proper physical examinations of the security officers and the failure to ensure that 10 contractor personnel were adequately trained prior to allowing unescorted access to the protected area.

An unresolved item involving the testing program for your metal detectors and x-ray machines is identified in paragraph 3.1 of the enclosed inspection report. This item was originally identified as an apparent violation during the exit interview conducted on February 21, 1992. However, Mr. Yelverton of your staff raised the question of a potential backfit issue with Mr. S. J. Collins of our office during a meeting at your facility on March 5, 1992. Accordingly, the questions raised by Mr. Yelverton will be reviewed as part of our plant-specific backfit evaluation process. We will advise you concerning the decision reached by the backfit panel at a later date.
