SUBJECT:	RECOMMENDED ENFORCEMENT ACTION - NEBRASKA PUBLIC POWER DISTRICT (NPPD) & EA NO. 95-012

I am recommending the issuance of the enclosed Notice of Violation to NPPD based on violations of the licensee's Technical Specifications and 10 CFR 50.9 at the licensee's Cooper Nuclear Station (CNS) facility.

This recommendation is based on an investigation report that was issued on August 3, 1994; a November 10, 1994 Demand for Information (DFI) to the licensee (EA 94-177); the licensee's December 12: 1994 response to the DFI; and the individual responses from the members of the CNS Station Operations Review Committee (SORC) and the former Site Manager, dated December 9-12, 1994. The justification for this recommended action is described in detail in the enclosed enforcement recommendation worksheet.


