SUBJECT: NRC INSPECTION REPORT NOS. 50-445/92-07; 50-446/92-07

This refers to the inspection conducted by Messrs. W. D. Johnson, G. E. Werner, and R. M. Latta, during the period February 2 through March 14, 1992. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for the Comanche Peak Steam Electric Station, Units 1 and 2. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with you and those members of your staff identified in the enclosed report.

Areas examined during the inspection included plant status, followup on previously identified items, NRC Bulletin followup, licensee event report followup, operational safety verification, onsite followup of events, maintenance observation, surveillance observation, and safety system verification. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observation by the inspectors.

Improvements in the material condition of the secondary plant, along with good overall material condition and cleanliness of the primary plant and support systems, were seen as a strength. Communication and coordination of surveillance and maintenance activities continued to be excellent. A questioning attitude and alert response by a radiation protection technician during planned maintenance on a motor-operated valve was commendable, preventing degradation of Unit 1 safety-related equipment. Weaknesses were noted in the self-verification area by several instances of both operations and maintenance personnel failing to use proper self-checking techniques.

Within the scope of the inspection, no violations or deviations were identified.
