SUBJECT: RESPONSE TO FOIA'S 83-451, -452, -454 and -449 FROM

B. GARDE ON MIDLAND

This will respond to the four subject FOIA's from Ms. Billie Garde. My search included my personal files and those maintained by Licensing Branch No. 4. Documents located by E. Adensam are also included.

FOIA 83-451

This FOIA asks for documents relevant to consideration of the TERA Corporation's IDCV program as one of the pilot programs under Section 13, Public Law 97-415 (i.e., the "Ford Amendment"). Ms. Garde identifies three meetings of specific interest, one of which occurred on June 22, 1983. The three meetings are aknowledged in TERA's July 15, 1983, Monthly Status Report (page 2 and Attachment 1, pages 5 and 6), publicly available. I visited the TERA Corporation on June 22, 1983, on a matter relevant to aspects of the IDCV program, but only remotely related to any consideration pursuant to Section 13, Public Law 97-415. My trip report dated July 1, 1983, is publicly available and is also attached. Note that the trip report inadvertantly identified the meeting date as April 22, 1983. rather than June 22, 1983. Also attached in my note to T. Novak of June 20, 1983, D. Eisenhut's June 2, 1983 memo, and B. Grime's May 5, 1983 memo.

I find no documents regarding the other two meetings, and I did not attend them. They were attended by IE personnel (B. Grimes, J. Stone, etc.).

FOIA 83-452

A transcript of the June 15, 1983, open Commission briefing was made and is publicly available. I also recall that the viewgraph slides I used during the briefing were inadvertantly omitted from the transcript and were forwarded by a followup letter. I am unable to locate the followup letter. but I believe it received the same distribution as the transcript and, therefore, should also be publicly available. I find no related documents that are not publicly available.

FOIA 83-449

This FOIA asks for material reviewed by NRR that led to T. Novak's letter of April 22, 1983, to CPCo rejecting TERA for the CIO. I can find no such letter. Moreover, the principal document by which NRC rejected TERA is attached; J. Keppler letter of March 28, 1983, to CPCO, paragraph C3. I believe a copy of TERA's letter of March 18, 1983, is publicly available, but am not certain of this (there were two March 18, 1983 letters from TERA, but only one relates to the subject matter, CIO). I will verify it is in the PDR and if it is not, this will be promptly corrected. A Consumers Power Company letter dated April 6, 1983, to J. Keppler is relevant and is publicly available.

Several other relevant doucments which may not be publicly available are attached.

FOIA 83-454

This FOIA requests documents regarding review of the structural adequacy of the Diesel Generator Building subsequent to May 1983, testimony of R. Landsman, Region III. All documents I find have been made publicly available. The principal documents located are (1) Board Notification 83-109 with its three enclosures, (2) D. Eisenhut's letter to Ms. B. Garde dated August 10, 1983, with its enclosure of team member resumes, and (3) a meeting notice for a August 24-27, 1983, Taskforce meeting and site visit.

The completed records for processing times for these responses by LB No. 4 are also enclosed.
