This refers to your letter dated July 9, 1984, in response to our letter dated June 4, 1984.


Thank you for informing us of the corrective and preventive actions documented in your letter. These actions will be examined during a future inspection of your licensed program.

With regard to your statement that this event was an isolated instance, we note that your statement is correct when only tests of the diesel generators are considered. We direct your attention to your internal upset report numbers two (May 15, 1984) and three (May 22, 1984). These upset reports identify two separate events which appear to have resulted from a lack of communication or test control between different shifts of operations and start-up personnel.
