Gentlemen:

Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Unit No. 2 IE Inspection 50-336/80-11

Reference (1) summarized Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO) efforts to date to install two new offstream liquid effluent monitors in a low background area and to prepare calibration sources which correlate to known liquid concentrations. These efforts resulted from a commitment made in response to IE Inspection 50-336/80-11.

Reference (1) also documented NNECO's intention of completing these actions by June 30, 1984.

The detailed work activities necessary to install the two new monitors are more extensive than originally estimated. The current schedule projects a November 30, 1984 inservice date for the monitors.

The Resident Inspector was informed of this matter on June 29, 1984. It is our intention to provide him with a detailed schedule of actions to be completed for this project. In addition a discussion of this matter was held between my staff and Region I personnel on July 2, 1984 at which time the revised inservice date proposed herein was found acceptable to both parties.

The radiation monitors currently installed in the liquid effluent stream are currently operating satisfactorily. Proper operation of all radiation monitors at Millstone Unit No. 2 is checked weekly.

Following installation of the monitors, calibration sources which correlate to known liquid concentrations will be prepared. A further update will be provided as required.

We trust you find this information satisfactory.
