On December 1, 1995, Region IV reported that a Fort Calhoun security officer was a suspect in a double homicide in Omaha, NE. On Tuesday morning, December 5, 1995, the Fort Calhoun Security Manager was advised by local authorities that the victims brother had been arrested and charged with the double homicide.
