Gentlemen:

This acknowledges the receipt of your letter dated February 28, 1992, by which you transmitted Revision 23 to your Industrial Security Plan.

The regional staff reviewed Revision 23 and determined that the revision is consistent with the requirements of 10 CFR 50.54(p). Many of the changes were administrative in nature.

One of the revisions concerned the definition of "every 12 months" as it applies to annual training requalification. While acceptable, the wording in the plan change does not conform to the suggested wording in the generic letter published by the Safeguards Branch, Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation, dated August 28, 1990, that defined "every 12 months." During a teleconference with your security staff, Messrs. Harold Hutchins and Harold Williams, committed to change the wording during a future revision to conform to the suggested wording contained in the above generic letter. The future revision will not cause any change to your training requirements.

The enclosures to your letter contain Safeguards Information of a type specified in 10 CFR 73.21 and are being withheld from public disclosure.


Gentlemen:

In accordance with 10CFR50.4, attached is the original plus three (3) copies (Copy Nos. 1-4) of Revision 23 to the Arkansas Nuclear One (ANO) Industrial Security Plan (ISP). Copies 5 and 6 are being submitted to NRC Region IV. A brief description of the changes made in this revision is included as Attachment 1 and the specific changes are shown in Attachment 2. Also included in this submittal are those changes to the ISP involving the deletion of a vital area from the plan. These changes represent Revision 22 and were approved by the Staff in letter dated December 18, 1991.

In accordance with 10CFR50.54(p), it was determined by Entergy Operations that those changes not previously reviewed by the NRC do not decrease the safeguards effectiveness of the plan and, therefore, are being implemented without prior NRC approval.

The attached material describes current and proposed security measures; therefore, Entergy Operations has determined that the attached documentation contains safeguards information as specified by 10CFR73.21. The attached documentation should therefore be handled appropriately.
