Access Authorization Program Certification

The purpose of this letter is to notify the NRC that Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) has established and implemented an access authorization program in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 73.56, "Personnel access authorization requirements for nuclear power plants." The access authorization program has been incorporated into the St. Lucie Plant and Turkey Point Plant Site Physical Security Plans per FPL letters L-92-42 dated March 10, 1992 and L-92-76, dated April 3, 1992, respectively. All elements of Regulatory Guide 5.66, "Access Authorization Program for Nuclear Power Plants," have been implemented to satisfy the requirements of 10 CFR 73.56.

On January 3, 1990, FPL implemented an access authorization program in accordance with the "Industry Guidelines for Nuclear Power Plant Access Authorization Programs", (NUMARC 89-01, August 1989). When Regulatory Guide 5.66 was published in June 1991, FPL conducted barround investigations and psychological evaluations on all per unel previously grandfathered on January 3, 1990, who did not have an uninterrupted unescorted access authorization for at least 180 days during the period from January 3, 1990 through April 25, 1991.
