TOPIC

The applicant presented his plans for the implementation of the security plan during the operation of Unit 1, while continuing construction of Unit 2. Discussion during this meeting contained Safeguards Information and therefore the meeting was not open to the public.

SUMMARY

The applicant presented proposed plans for the separation of the operations from the construction functions at the Braidwood site. These proposals provided specific safeguards measures to be employed to meet the requirements described in 10 CFR 73.55 for physical barriers, access controls, and detection aids. Special attention was given to the protection of certain pieces of vital equipment. These measures will be included in the next revision to the site physical security plan which will be submitted to the NRC for review and approval prior to operating license issuances. As a result of this discussion, agreement was reached on the above issues.

Mr. Brennan of the corporate office was reminded that there were several concerns related to the protecting of vital equipment at their Byron site. Follow-up discussions were planned for the resolution of these issues in the next several weeks.

Specific details of the discussions have been determined to be Safeguards Information as described in 10 CFR 73.21 and are being withheld from public disclosure.
