Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. J. R. Boardman of this office during the period June 4-8, 1984, of activities authorized by NRC Construction Permit CPPR-103 for the Waterford Steam Electric Station Unit 3, and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. L. F. Storz, and other members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during the inspection included followup on significant construction deficiencies and maintenance.

Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector. These findings are documented in the enclosed inspection report.

During this inspection, it was found that certain of your activities were in violation of NRC requirements. Consequently, you are required to respond to these violations, in writing, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2.201 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations. Your response should be based on the specifics contained in the Notice of Violation enclosed with this letter. Additional potential violations described herein have been combined with similar violations. These will be promulgated by separate correspondence.

We have also examined actions you have taken with regard to previously identified inspection findings. The status of these items is identified in paragraph 2 of the enclosed report.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(a), a copy of this letter and the enclosures will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room unless you notify this office, by telephone, within 10 days of the date of this letter, and submit written application to withhold information contained therein within 30 days of the date of this letter. Such application must be consistent with the requirements of 2.790(b)(1).

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The response directed by this letter and the accompanying Notice is not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Management and Budget as required by the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, PL 96-511.

Should you have any questions concerning this inspection, we shall be pleased to discuss them with you.
