SUBJECT: CLOSEOUT OF NRC BULLETIN 88-10, NONCONFORMING MOLDED CASE CIRCUIT BREAKERS, SEABROOK STATION, UNIT 1, MPA X810 (TAC NO. M71352)

The purpose of this letter is to inform you we have reviewed your response to NRC Bulletin 88-10 and now consider the issue closed.

By your letters number NYN-89035, dated March 31, 1989, number NYN-89071, dated May 31, 1989, number NYN-89103, dated August 11, 1989, and number NYN-90119, dated May 31, 1990, New Hampshire Yankee responded to NRC Bulletin 88-10 and NRC Bulletin 88-10, Supplement 1, for the Seabrook Station, Unit 1. In NYN-89035 you indicated the results of ongoing efforts to determine the procurement chain of molded case circuit breakers (MCCB's) in inventory with the potential for use in safety-related applications at Seabrook Station, and actions taken to date or planned with respect to MCCB's in this category for which the procurement chain is not traceable to a circuit breaker manufacturer (CBM). In NYN-89071, you presented an update describing the New Hampshire Yankee (NHY) ongoing and planned actions to ensure that Class 1E MCCB's installed or in inventory at Seabrook Station were procured from a CBM. In NYN-89103, you indicated efforts to determine the traceability of Class IE MCCB's, within the scope of the NRC Bulletin 2° 10, have been completed to the extent possible.

In NYN-90119, you indicated NHY has verified that actions described in NYN-89103 were fully responsive to NRC Bulletin 88-10 as clarified by Supplement 1, and NHY reviewed construction related procurement records for MCCB's. In NYN-90119, NHY concluded that letters NYN-89103 and NYN-90119 provide the complete response to NRC Bulletin 88-10 and its associated Supplement 1.

Therefore, we consider this issue closed and TAC No. M71352 is closed by this letter. The staff may conduct an inspection of your implementation at a later time.
