RESOLUTION NO. 171-1984

I offer the following Resolution and move its adoption:

RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of Harrisburg calls upon the Nuclear Regulatory Commission to not license General Public Utilities to operate Three Mile Island Unit I because:

- 1. GPU has demonstrated a total lack of management integrity;
- There exists no workable or realistic evacuation plan for the TMI area;
- There is no complete funding plan for the clean up of Unit II; and
- 4. The voters of Dauphin, Lebanon and Cumberland counties have completely rejected the restart of Unit I.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that since Presidential candidate Walter Mondale has stated his opposition to restart of Unit I while candidate Ronald Reagan supports restart, it seems appropriate that no final decision should be made on the restart until after the November General Election; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be sent to the officials of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission.
