SUBJECT: CRYSTAL RIVER UNIT 3 - SECOND 10-YEAR INTERVAL INSERVICE INSPECTION PROGRAM PLAN (TAC NO. M68246)

By letter dated February 9, 1988, as supplemented May 25, 1990 and June 7, 1991, Florida Power Corporation (FPC) submitted its Second 10-Year Interval Inservice Inspection (ISI) Program Plan for Crystal River Unit 3 (CR-3). Included were related relief requests where it was determined that certain requirements in Section XI of the ASME Code (Code) were impractical to perform. These relief requests were previously approved or found to be unnecessary by the NRC in letters dated April 19, 1988, September 28, 1988, May 30, 1990 and September 13, 1991.

With technical assistance from our contractor, the Idaho National Engineering Laboratory, we have evaluated the program plan, the additional information and the relief requests, as summarized in the enclosed Safety Evaluation and the contractor's Technical Evaluation Report. Based on this evaluation, we have concluded that the ISI Program Plan is in compliance with 10 CFR 50.55a(g), and is therefore acceptable.

This completes our actions on TAC No. M68246.
