A . 16 What did you do? 2. 17 A. I assisted Jackie Ables in prepping two 18 welds. 19 When did you leave work that night? 0. A. At 1:30. 20 21 was the preparation of these welds finished at that time? 22 23 A. No, it wasn't. 24 Q. Was someone still working on the welds when you left? 25

11	Q. When you left work at 1:30 a.m. were those
