JAMES E. BROWN. 1 2 the witness hereinbefore named, being first duly 3 cautioned and sworn to testify the truth, the whole 4 truth and nothing but the truth, testified on his 5 oath as follows: MR. WATKINS: My name is McNeill 6 7 Watkins. I'm with the law firm of Bishop, Liberman, 8 Cook, Purcell & Reynolds in Washington, D. C. Wa are counsel for Applicants in this licensing 9 proceeding. This is the prefiled testimony of Mr. 10 11 James Brown, a Brown & Root employee at Comanche Peak. He is appearing here voluntarily for this 12 13 deposition and has not been subpoensed by any party. 14 EXAMINATION BY MR. WATKINS: 15 16 Q. Mr. Brown, would you please state your full 17 name. 18 James E. Brown. 19 0. By whom are you employed? Brown & Root, Incorporated. 20 A . Where are you employed? 21 0. Comanche Peak Steam Electric Station. 22 A . What is your title, Mr. Brown? 23 0. 24 Chief Timekeeper and Payroll Supervisor. A .

How long have you held that position?

25

Q.

- A. A little over five years.
- Q. Where, physically, is your office located at Comanche Peak?
 - A. In the Time Office.

- Q. Would you briefly describe your duties?
- A. I am responsible for documentation of hours worked by Brown & Root employees on the job site.
- Q. How does the Time Office keep track of the number of hours that each Brown & Root hourly employee works on a given day?
- A. As the employees come to work, they're issued a brass with an employee identification number on it, and then we go behind them and log the time that they pick their brass up. At the end of the day, whenever they leave for the day, the employees drop their brass of; we log them out.
- Q. Do Time Office personnel write down the times that Brown & Root employees check in and out?
- A. In most cases we don't actually write down the time, no. What we do is, when an employee comes in at the beginning of a shift, Time Office personnel put a pencil mark down for that employee. The pencil marks are color-coded to shifts. For example, a blue pencil mark would mean that the employee clocked in on the 5:30 a.m. shift, and a

- report d for work on the 7:30 a.m. shift. The reason we use color codes is that on some shifts we have over a thousand people reporting or leaving at the same time. It's not feasible for the Time Office to write down the times.
 - Q. What happens if a shift employee reports for or leaves work at a time other than the normal shift?
 - A. Then we write down the actual time that the employee reports or leaves.
 - Q. Do the Time Office people use a form for recording the times that Brown & Root employees report for and leave work?
 - A. Yes, sir. We use a Brown & Root Labor Control Sheet.
 - Q. Mr. Brown, I'll show you the document that's been marked for identification as Brown Exhibit 1 and ask you if that is a blank copy of the Labor Control Sheet to which you just referred.
 - A. Yes, sir, it is.
 - Q. Mr. Brown, are these Labor Control Sheets filled out daily for each Brown & Root hourly employee that works at Comanche Peak?
 - A. Daily, yes.

1 O. Does the Time Office retain these Labor Control Sheets after they have been filled out? 2. A. Yes, sir. They are the basis for paying 3 Brown & Root employees. 4 5 Q. After they are filled out, do they remain in your personal possession and control? 6 A. Yes, sir. 8 Q. Physically where do you keep, and how do you keep, these Labor Control Sheets once they have 9 been filled out for a given week? 10 Each week the Labor Control Sheets and 11 A . 12 other documentation are bound together for each week-ending period. 13 Q. Mr. Brown, do you have all of the Brown & 14 15 Boot hourly Labor Control Sheets for the week ending January the 14th, 1984, here with you at this time? 16 A. Yes, sir. I have before me the binder 17 including all Labor Control Sheets for that week. 18 Are those Labor Control Sheets the 19 originals? 20 21 A. Yes, sir. 22 Q. Mr. Brown, how do the Labor Control Sheets identify employees? 23 A. By badge number. 24

Is there a list of names and corresponding

badge numbers for all Brown & Root employees at 1 Comanche Peak? 2 3 A. Yes, sir. Q. Would you describe that list, please? 4 5 A. It's called a timekeeper's listing. It's a 6 computer printout that lists all the employees alphabetically. The list gives their badge number and other information. 9 Q. How often is the list updated? 10 A. Once a week. 11 Do you have a current list with you at this 0. 12 time? Yes, sir. 13 A . 14 Q. Mr. Brown, is Ronald McBee a Brown & Root 15 employee at Comanche Peak? 16 A. Yes, sir. Q. What is his badge number? 17 A. 3164. 18 19 Is Richard Simpson a Brown & Root employee 0. at Comanche Peak? 20 A. Yes, sir. 21 22 What is Mr. Simpson's badge number? 0. A. 8554. 23 Is Alan Justice a Brown & Root employee at 24 25 Comanche Peak?

- 1 A. Yes, sir. What is Mr. Justice's badge number? 0. 3 2371. A. 4 Is Danny Wright an employee of Brown & Root 5 at Comanche Peak? 6 Yes, sir. A. 7 What is Mr. Wright's badge number? 0. 8 5823. A. 9 Q. Mr. Brown, have you established each of the badge numbers for those individuals by reference to 10 11 the computer printout that you have before you as you testify today? 12 A. Yes, sir, I have. 13 14 Mr. Brown, if a badge number includes the prefix HQ, what does that indicate? 15 A. QC inspectors at Comanche Peak are carried 16 on the Brown & Root Houston payroll completely 17 18 separate from the site Craft personnel. An "HQ" badge number indicates that the employee is on the 19 20 Houston payroll. Q. Are employees with "HQ" badge numbers 21 listed on your timekeeper's list? 22 23 No, they are not. A .
 - Q. Is there a separate list of Comanche Peak employees carried on the Houston payroll?

Earlier you testified that Jack Stanford's badge number is HQ-10. Does Brown Exhibit 2 show that Jack Stanford worked on Saturday, January the 8 14th? 9 10 A . Yes, sir, it does. 11 When did he clock in that day? 0. A. 7 o'clock a.m. 12 When did he leave on that day? 13 0. A . 3:30 p.m. 14 15 Q. Mr. Brown, I show you five additional documents which have been marked for identification 16 as Brown Exhibits 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7, and ask you to 17 identify them. 18 A. These are copies of Labor Control Sheets 19 for Brown & Root Comanche Peak employees for the 20 week ending January 14, 1984. 21 Q. Have you compared those exhibits with the originals in the binder that is in your possession? 23

Q. And that binder is for the week ending

A. Yes, sir.

January the 14th, 1984; is that correct? Yes, sir. 2 A . 3 Q. Earlier you testified that Ronald McBee's 4 badge number was 3164. Referring to Brown Exhibits 5 4 through 7, can you state whether Mr. McBee worked on Saturday, January the 14th? 6 A. Yes, sir, he did. Q. To which exhibit are you referring? Brown Exhibit 4. 9 A. 10 Q. What hours did Mr. McBee work on January 11 the 14th? 12 A. From 7 o'clock a.m. till 1:30 Sunday 13 morning. 14 Q. Is there an actual notation as to the time he checked out on the 14th? 15 16 Yes, sir, there is. A . Q. What is that notation? 17 A. 0130. 18 19 Q. Does that mean he left work at 1:30 a.m. on Sunday morning, January the 15th? 20 A. Yes, sir. 21 Q. Earlier you gave Richard Simpson's badge 22 number as 8554. Referring to Brown Exhibits 4 23 through 7, can you tell me whether Mr. Simpson 24 worked on January the 14th? 25

2	Q. To which exhibit are you referring?
3	A. Brown Exhibit 7.
4	Q. When did Mr. Simpson check in that day?
5	A. 7 c'clock a.m.

24	Q. Earlier you gave Alan Justice's badge

1 through 7, can you state whether Mr. Justice worked on January the 14th, 1984? 2 Yes, sir, he did. 3 To which exhibit are you referring? 4 Brown Exhibit 3. A . What time did Mr. Justice commence work? 0. 7 o'clock a.m. A . And when did Mr. Justice leave work on the 8 9 14th? 10 A. 2:30 Sunday morning. 11 Q. So he left work on January the 15th at 2:30 a.m.; is that correct? 12 13 A. Correct. Q. Earlier you gave Jackie Ables' badge number 14 as 7794. Referring to the exhibits before you, can 15 16 you state whether Mr. Ables worked on January the 17 14th, 1984? 18 A. Yes, sir, he did. Q. To which exhibit are you referring? 19 A. Brown Exhibit 6. 20 O. What time did Mr. Ables commence work on January the 14th? 22 A. Seven o'clock a.m. 23 And when did he leave? 24 0.

2:30 a.m. Sunday morning.

And that would be January the 15th; is that correct? 3 A. Correct. 4 Q. Mr. Brown, for each of the individuals that 5 we have just identified and discussed, the time that 6 they began work that morning is not actually recorded by number, is it? 7 8 A. No, sir, it's not. Are they referred to by color code on the 9 10 original Labor Control Sheets? 11 A. Yes, sir, they are. 12 Q. Have you compared the markings on the copies of the Labor Control Sheets that have been 13 marked as Brown Exhicits 4 through 7 in this 14 proceeding with the original color codes in the 15 binder that is in your possession? 16 Yes, sir, I have. 17 18 Q. And on that basis your testimony is that each of these individuals commenced work at seven 19 a.m. on January the 14th; is that correct? 20 A. Yes, sir, that's correct. 21 22 O. Mr. Brown, is there any independent means of verifying when an employee leaves work at 23 Comanche Peak other than the Labor Control Sheets? 24

A. Yes, sir. Oftentimes they will sign out in

1 my office, when my people are not available to actually log them out at that time when they leave. 3 Q. And when they sign out, is there a form used for that purpose? 5 A. Yes, sir. Q. Are these forms retained in your possession, supervision and control in the Time Office? 8 A. Yes, sir. 9 Q. Mr. Brown, I'll show you a document that's 10 been marked as Brown Exhibit 8. Would you identify 11 that document, please. 12 A. This is a copy of the sign+out sheet for Brown & Root employees who leave other than their 13 regular scheduled time, for January 14, 1984. 14 15 Q. Does it record the names of any of the 16 gentlemen that you have discussed in your testimony? 17 A. Yes, sir. 18 0. Who are those? 19 Jackie Ables and Alan Justice. A . What time does it show that they signed out? 20 0. At 2:30 a.m. 21 A. Now, the sign-out sheet is for January the 22 0. 14th. Earlier you testified that these gentlemen 23 left work at 2:30 a.m. on the 15th. Could you 24

explain that?

- A. The first person on the top of this page, I know personally, comes in at 11 o'clock p.m. every night. And so that's p.m. The sign-ins and sign-outs on this sheet start on January 14, but spills over into the early morning hours of January 15.
 - Q. Does that conclude your testimony?
 - A. Yes, it does.

MR. WATKINS: Thank you, Mr. Brown.

THE WITNESS: Okay.

MR. WATKINS: For the record, Mr.

Brown has with him at this deposition the computer printout that he described in his testimony. The computer printout is quite bulky, and it would be difficult to introduce individual pages from the printout. Mr. Brown also has the original Labor Control Sheets showing the color codes for the week ending January the 14th, 1984. The color coded sheets must remain in Mr. Brown's possession and control at the Time Office at Comanche Peak, so we will not attempt to introduce the originals of these documents into evidence.

Applicants move the admission of Brown Exhibits

1 through 8 into evidence. Anticipating a possible
hearsay objection to Exhibits 2 through 8,

Applicants invoke the business records exception to the rule. Federal Rule of Evidence 803(6) provides that business records are not excluded by the rule against hearsay if such records are shown by the custodial of such records that they are kept in the course of a regularly conducted business activity, and if such records were kept as part of regular practice.

Mr. Brown has testified that he is the custodian of the Labor Control Sheets, and that they are made out and kept in the regular course of business, all within the meaning of the Rule 803(6).
