This letter is to provide additional information to our request of July 18 regarding the Northrop building, as briefly discussed on July 30 with Ms. Myers.

A diagram of the Northrop building is enclosed. An ongoing research program using radiolabeled compounds is to be relocated to the leased facility. The program will occupy the labs noted on the diagram by room number and size. The research in progress is the comparative assessment of dermal absorption of toxicants. The compounds are i4-C and 3-H labeled, although other nuclides may be used in the future upon review and approval of our Radiation Safety Committee. The space is equipped with Kewaunee and Bioguard hoods.
