MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

(Requesting Information from the NRC Staff)

In preparation for the upcoming evidentiary hearing concerning the parties' rebuttal and surrebuttal testimony, the Board is reviewing the documents proffered by the parties as exhibits in support of their responsive testimony. In examining Table 1 on page 12 of the NRC staff's proposed Exhibit 73, we find that because the terminal blocks tested are identified by an assigned number rather than by a manufacturer name and model number, we are unable to discern which of the terminal blocks tested correspond to the terminal blocks that are at issue in this proceeding.

So that we can fully understand this table, we request that by close of business on Monday, April 27, 1992, the staff provide the Board and Alabama Power Company with a memorandum identifying the correlation, in terms of the

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
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manufacturer and model number, between the terminal blocks listed in Table 1 to proposed Staff Exhibit 73 and those at issue in this proceeding. In its memorandum, the staff also should identify the source of the information provided.

Alabama Power Company may file any response to the staff's memorandum by close of business on Friday, May 1, 1992.
