Gentlemen:

This acknowledges the receipt of your letter dated March 3, 1992, by which you transmitted Revision 12 to the CPSES Physical Security Plan for your facility. The Regional staff has reviewed the information contained in Revision 12 and have determined that portions of Revision 12 are consistent with the provisions of 10 CFR 50.54(p) and are, therefore, acceptable. However, as indicated in the Safeguards Attachment, one of the changes decreases plan effectiveness and is, therefore, inconsistent with the provisions of 10 CFR 50.54(p). As discussed with Mr. J. Ardizzoni of your staff on April 7, 1992, you are to follow your previously approved plan in regard to these items. Please resubmit a corrected plan in order to maintain plan continuity.

Should you wish to pursue changing the security plan with respect to the changes set forth in the Attachment, you should resubmit under the provisions of 10 CFR 50.90.

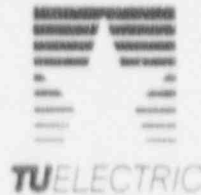
Change Considered to be Unacceptable

Para/Change	<u>Comments</u>
2.3.6.1	The change is unacceptable as written. The change reduces the effectiveness of the plan. Current requirements of your Safeguards Contingency Plan requires that the security force conduct operations to protect the plant during civil disturbances. The explanation of the requested change does not reference what measures you intend to use to compensate for the reduction in civil disturbance equipment that you propose to eliminate from your inventory (nightsticks and gas masks). Your explanation of changes does not propose to reduce or eliminate the contingency plan commitment, only the equipment necessary to adequately protect the plant during that contingency.


Gentlemen:
