The amendment authorizes you to possess a sealed source of up to 5 millicuries activity and modifies the Technical Specifications (T5) to include surveillance and recordkeeping requirements for this source. Also, the license condition which permitted possession of 3.2 kilograms of contained uranium at greater than 20 percent enrichment has been deleted since this fuel has been removed from your facility.
