SUBJECT: PEACH BOTTOM RETAKE SIMULATOR TESTS

Dear Mr. Smith:

In a telephone conversation on December 4, 1995, between Mr. D. Florek and Mr. D. McClellan, arrangements were made for the administration of retake simulator examinations at the Peach Bottom Atomic Power Station.

The simulator tests are scheduled for January 11, 1996.

To prepare the examinations and meet the above schedule, it will be necessary for your staff to furnish your revised Technical Specifications by December 18, 1995.

The NRC will prepare and administer the operating tests in accordance with ES-301 and ES-302 of NUREG-1021. In order to conduct the requested operating tests, it will be necessary for your staff to make the simulation facility available on the dates noted above. Your staff should retain the original simulator performance data (e.g., system pressures, temperatures, and levels) generated during the dynamic operating tests until the examination results are final.

Final, signed applications certifying that all training has been completed should be submitted by January 4, 1996.

This request is covered by Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Clearance Number 3150-0101, which expires October 31, 1995. The estimated average burden is 7.7 hours per response, includes gathering, xeroxing, and mailing the required material.
