EMERGENCY PLAN CHANGES FOR NORTH ANNA POWER STATION (TAC NOS. M93602
AND M93603)

Dear Mr. O'Hanlon:

By letter dated September 6, 1995, you proposed revisions to the North Anna Power Station Emergency Plan. These revisions would modify the mobilization commitment for selected emergency staffing positions intended to augment the onshift response capabilities during an emergency. The proposed savings would be realized by no longer requiring certain onshift positions to be staffed.

With these proposed revisions, you also specified facility activation goals. At an Alert or higher classification, the local emergency operations facility (LEOF) for North Anna and the technical support center (TSC) and operational support center (OSC) would have an activation goal of 60 minutes at an Alert or higher classification.

As a result of our review, we have determined that your proposed revisions would not decrease the effectiveness of the currently approved emergency plan for the North Anna Power Station. The proposed changes would add only 15 minutes to the response time for selected emergency staffing positions. The extended response time for these positions is considered a reasonable exception to the goals and criteria used to determine acceptability of a licensee's emergency response capabilities. Therefore, the staff has determined that revising the plans as you have proposed would not alter the staff's previous conclusion that the North Anna plans met the standard required by 10 CFR 50.47(b)(2). For this reason, we recommend approval of your proposed emergency plan changes. The staff's Safety Evaluation regarding these matters is enclosed.
