This refers to the special safety inspection conducted by Mr. F. J. Jablonski of this office on May 29-31, June 1, 26-28, and July 11-13, 1984, and Mr. R. C. Knop on July 11-12, 1984, of activities at the Clinton Power Station, Unit 1, authorized by NRC Construction Permit No. CPPR-137 and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. D. Hall at the conclusion of the inspection.
