Supplemental Report of Facility Changes, Tests and Experiments

Reference: Report of Facility Changes, Tests and Experiments, dated May 5, 1995

In accordance with 10 CFR 50.59, a supplement to the Annual Report of Facility Changes, Tests, and Experiments for the Beaver Valley Power Station, Unit No. 2, is attached. This report provides brief descriptions of facility and procedure changes and a summary of safety evaluations for several temporary modifications which were not included in the May 5, 1995 report. Because these changes were temporary and did not result in FSAR revisions, these items were omitted from the original report.

Each change was evaluated to determine (1) if the probability of occurrence or the consequences of an accident or malfunction of equipment important to safety previously evaluated in the Updated Final Safety Analysis Report may be increased, or (2) if a possibility for an accident or malfunction of a different type than any evaluated previously in the Updated Final Safety Analysis Report may be created, or (3) if the margin of safety as defined in the basis for any technical specification is reduced. In each case, it was determined that the change did not constitute an unreviewed safety question as defined in 10 CFR 50.59.
