SUBJECT: WITHDRAWAL OF AMENDMENT REQUEST - SEQUOYAH NUCLEAR PLANT UNIT 1
(TAC NO. M82801) (TS 92-02)

By letter dated February 20, 1992, TVA submitted a request for changes to the Technical Specifications for the Sequoyah Nuclear Plant, Unit 1. The amendment requested temporary changes related to the Reactor Coolant System (RCS) resistance temperature detector (RTD) allowable values (overtemperature differential temperature, overpower differential temperature, loop differential temperature) and the channel calibration requirements for the RCS RTDs. The proposed change was needed due to test instrument errors that occurred during Unit 1 startup following the Cycle 6 refueling outage that invalidated the RCS RTD sensor calibration. On February 27, 1992, the Commission issued a proposed finding that the amendment would involve no significant hazards consideration (57 FR 6748).

By letter dated April 13, 1992, TVA informed the staff that the proposed amendment was being withdrawn because it is no longer needed. The RTD calibrations will be reperformed during the plant startup following an unscheduled shutdown that occurred before the date when the amendment was needed.

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We have filed the enclosed Notice of Withdrawal of an Amendment Request to Facility Operating License DPR-77 with the Office of the Federal Register for publication in the next available issue of the FEDERAL REGISTER. This action closes TAC No. 82801.
