Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) of a typographical error in, and requested a change to, the Technical Specifications issued with the renewal of the operating license for the Maryland University Training Reactor (MUTR) dated August 7, 1984.

We have determined that the change is administrative in nature, and requires no safety evaluation, since the amended version is the one that was evaluated during our review for license renewal.

We also have determined that this change is in the category of record-keeping, reporting, and administrative procedures and requirements. Accordingly, this amendment meets the eligibility criteria for categorical exclusion set forth in 10 CFR 51.22(c)(10). Pursuant to 10 CFR 51.22(b), no environmental impact statement or environmental assessment need be prepared in connection with the issuance of this amendment.

The staff has concluded, based on the considerations discussed above, that: (1) there is reasonable assurance that the health and safety of the public will not be endangered by operation in the proposed manner, and (2) such activities will be conducted in compliance with the Commission's regulations and the issuance of this amendment will not be inimical to the common defense and security or to the health and safety of the public.
