Dear Mr. Russell:

In the Reference 1 letter we transmitted to you the Core Operating Limits Report (COLR) for Cycle 14 operation of the DAEC. In accordance with Technical Specification (TS) Section 6.11.2.d, attached is Revision 1 to the Cycle 14 COLR. This revision incorporates the results of two equipment out-of-service evaluations. The first is for one Turbine Bypass Valve being inoperable and the other allows for the End-of-Cycle Recirculation Pump Trip logic to be unavailable. The latter evaluation is in support of a pending TS change request (Reference 2). In addition, we have included the "exclusion zone" power-to-flow operating map in this COLR revision in support of our implementation of the Option I-D solution for thermal-hydraulic instability, as described in Reference 3.

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No new commitments are being made in this letter.
