SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF MEETING ON LIMERICK TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

On August 15, 1984, members of the NRC staff met with representatives of the Philadelphia Electric Company in Bethesda, Maryland. A list of attendees is provided in the Enclosure.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the further development of the draft Limerick Unit 1 Technical Specifications (TS) transmitted with the staff's letter dated July 31, 1984. The major topics discussed are as follows:

- The applicant identified certain charges of a typographical and editorial nature which completed the resolution of issues previously discussed.
- o The staff noted that additional input would need to be accommodated as a result of the NRC technical staff's proof and review effort and the PECo response to the staff's July 31, 1984 letter.
- o It was noted by the staff and the applicant that the schedule changes identified in the applicant's letters dated July 17, 1984 and June 21, 1984, would also have to be reflected in the TS as needed.
- o The staff noted that the applicant's response, not yet received, to the requests for information on the offsite dose calculation manual would have to be received, reviewed and reflected in the TS.
- The staff noted that the referenced exemptions from Appendix J in section 3/4-6 would require additional attention prior to licensing.
