The concern of this Bulletin is General Electric Type HFA relay failures. General Electric's recommended corrective action is to replace the magnetic coil assembly or entire relay with Century series "Tefzel" coil spools.

A complete review of the potential impact of this Bulletin on all safety related purchase orders for Hope Creek Generating Station was made. In all cases, Century series relays were used or magnetic coil assemblies were replaced with those having "Tefzel" coil spools, except for four (4) relays. Coil replacement for these four relays was completed. It will be documented by General Electric on Field Disposition Instruction (FDI) # WTFF by October 1, 1984.
