Q1. How will CPSES respond to specific items in trip report?

A1. By letter. The five items requiring additional information (items 4, 12, 13, 16 and 19) shall be addressed specifically and the other items shall be addressed in a table similar to the one used during our 2-2-83 meeting.

Q2. Can CPSES commit to complete the incomplete items by fuel load?
