This will confirm our telephone conversations concerning your petition for enforcement of the antitrust license conditions attached to the captioned nuclear units.

Pursuant to our conversations, the Staff will await your comments on the August 10, 1984 letter from the Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PGandE) regarding your petition. As I advised, the NRC staff, in connection with its review of this matter, would like a copy of the wheeling provisions of the arbitrated settlement agreement reached with PGandE concerning NCPA's Geyser Units. In addition, the Staff would also like to review Mr. Robert Grimshaw's affidavit filed earlier this year in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of California on behalf of the City Healdsburg.
