
As you may be aware, the Commission, on July 18, 1984, issued Facility Operating License NPF-24, which authorizes fuel loading and precritical testing at Catawba Nuclear Station, Unit 1. Supplement No. 3 to the Safety Evaluation Report (SER) for Catawba was also issued. Issuance of the above-cited license by the Director, Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation, was authorized by the Licensing Board Memorandum and Order (Authorizing Issuance of a License to Load Fuel and Conduct Certain Precritical Testing), dated May 30, 1984.

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I am forwarding, for your information, copies of Facility Operating License NPF-24 and Supplement No. 3 to the Catawba SER. The licensing package enclosed herewith also contains the pertinent Federal Register Notice, the Environmental Protection Plan, Amendment No. 1 to Indemnity Agreement No. B-100, Antitrust Conditions and terms which the Staff is proposing to include in a low power license. The Technical Specifications which accompany Facility Operation License NPF-24 have not been included.
